Library Policy for Children

- 1. Parents or caregivers are responsible for the supervision of their children at all times. Children under 8 years of age may not be left unattended at the library. Children under 8 must be accompanied by a caregiver who is at least 12 years of age. If a child under 8 years of age is left unattended during or after library hours, parents will be notified. If parents cannot be notified, police will be called.
- 2. Children behaving in an unsafe, disruptive or disrespectful manner will be asked to leave the library. Repetitive misbehavior may be documented in an incident report and may result in loss of library privileges.
- 3. Parents and guardians are responsible for their children's use library resources and materials. This is not the library's responsibility.
- 4. Children or their caregivers must sign up for use of designated library resources and materials, and time limits must be respected.
